Katie went to college at Towson University and to law school at University of Baltimore. While attending law school, she met fellow law student Martin O'Malley, and they got married in 1990. They have four children, Grace, Tara, William, and Jack.

Katie has spent much of her life and her career serving the people in her community and her state. She was an early and tireless advocate for marriage equality and equal rights for the LGBTQ+ community. Her nearly 30 years of service and intimate knowledge of our criminal justice system, perspective as a woman and deep roots in Maryland, make Katie the best person to be Maryland's next Attorney General and the first woman to serve as Maryland's top law enforcement officer.
